Limited-time Snap-on® Products for Camo Season

KENOSHA, Wis. (Oct. 24, 2024)—It's that time of year when everything from the woods to the runways is filled with camo products. If you look closely, you can even spot these exclusive Snap-on® camouflage pattern products in the shop and out in the wild. The power tools are available for a limited time, while the apparel is available throughout the year.

Snap-on® CK861SDRILCMK2 collection includes this lineup of limited-time, camo-patterned power tools along with two batteries and a charger:

CT861CM 14.4 V 3/8" Drive MicroLithium Cordless Impact Wrench features an innovative compact design that holds a powerhouse of 150 ft-lb of torque output and 225 ft-lb of breakaway torque – 25 percent more power than previous models. In its durable, compact housing, this brushless impact is a shop necessity, now in camo, makes reaching into cramped spaces and tackling the most common fasteners easier and more efficient.



CDR861CM 14.4 V 3/8" Drive MicroLithium Cordless Drill has 200 in-lb of torque output in a lightweight, camouflage housing that's built to handle a wide variety of applications. The two-speed gearbox (450/1,550 RPM) for low and high-speed drilling has a variable-speed, featherable trigger. A nine-position clutch allows for optional torque settings, while the 3/8" keyless single-sleeve steel chuck makes it easy to change bits, and the non-slip grip helps with control and comfort.



CTS861CM 14.4 V 1/4" Hex MicroLithium Cordless Toggle Screwdriver has 200 in-lb of torque output packed into a 2 lb battery tool. The digital, variable-speed, toggle-style trigger means precise control, even in tight workspaces. A two-speed gearbox with options for 450 or 1,550 RPM and a nine-position clutch allows technicians to dial in proper torque. The 300 in-lb manual spindle lock helps break free or snug fasteners. This camo-covered screwdriver has a cushioned grip and twin-beam headlights to illuminate dark work areas.



CTR861ACM 14.4 V 3/8" MicroLithium Cordless Ratchet may be camouflaged, but it has 60 ft-lb of torque output for bigger jobs and 158 ft-lb of manual torque for the most stubborn fasteners. A brushless motor increases runtime, and the auto-trigger feature shuts the tool off after two minutes of continuous use. The 275 RPM free speed ratchet makes quick work of removing fasteners, while a built-in brake stops the tool from throwing them.



CTLED861CM 14.4 V MicroLithium 500 Lumen Cordless Work Light provides 500-lumen output via a high-quality LED bulb housed in a 120° rotating head with a tempered glass lens. The 13-hour run time indicates a 10-minute low battery warning. The tool may be decked out in camo, but the impact-modified, glass-filled nylon housing is designed to resist automotive fluids and the effects of other shop rigors.



Snap-on® Heated Camo Jackets and Hoodies keep techs warm in traditional outerwear styles with camo on the outside and hidden heating systems on the inside. The heated outerwear line with trademarked Snap-on® camouflage design is available in sizes S to 4X and comes in three styles – a zip-up jacket, a classic pull-over hoodie, and a zip-up hoodie. All three styles are made of durable wind and water-resistant material outside and fleece lining with pockets on the inside. They all contain dual heating zones: back, chest, and front hand pockets, and have three heat settings for each zone. All styles and sizes include a Snap-on® EEBC14400USB battery pack that can be held within the discreet pockets. The Camo Jacket HCJKTPMCMA has a removeable hood and adjustable cuffs and waist, while the two hoodie styles have attached hoods and elastic cuffs and waist.
