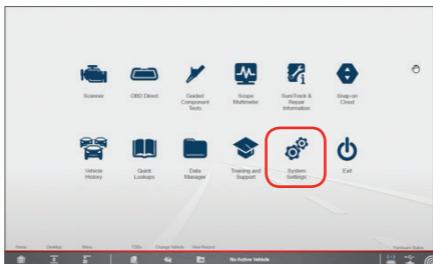

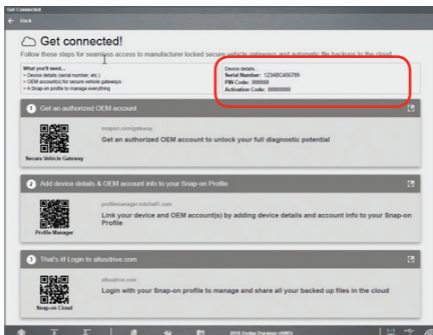
WHAT YOU'LL NEED IN ADVANCE

You'll need some information from your scan tool to get started - this can be found in **"System Settings"**.



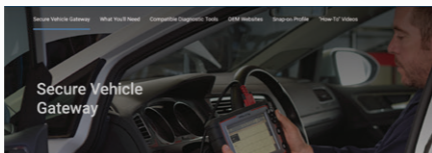
Select **"Get connected!"**

This information has all the **device information** you will need to complete registration. It also provides an overview of all the registration steps and required hyperlinks.

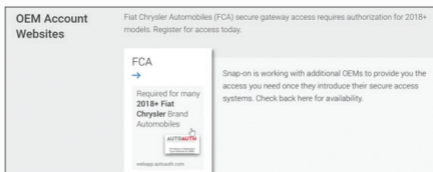
To get a complete overview of the registration process, go to snapon.com/gateway or use **QR code 1** on the tool.

Go to **AutoAuth.com**.



This site is used to register users and service centers to the FCA databases.

(If new OEMs are added, links will be provided at snapon.com/gateway.)

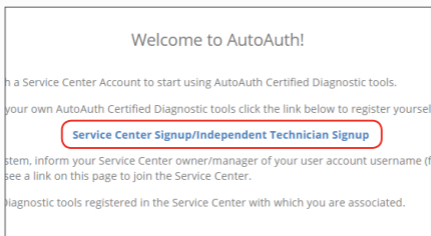

Check your email for confirmation and to verify the account.

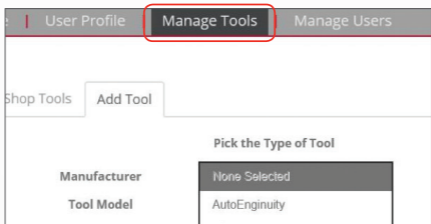
4 After validating the account, follow the on-screen instructions.

5 Once logged in, you'll be presented with a link to register yourself or your Service Center.



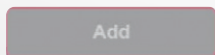
This link will allow you to register the name of the workshop, and you will need to input your individual account credentials as well. AutoAuth charges a **\$50 annual fee** for using their authentication services. After inputting the necessary information, click the **“Sign Up”** button at the bottom of the screen.

6 Select **“Manage Tools,”** then complete the required fields: *Manufacturer, Model and Serial Number.*



Your account and workshop must be established first. This will link your diagnostic equipment to the AutoAuth website.

7 To finalize this action, click the **“Add”** button.



Your AutoAuth account is now complete.

SNAP-ON PROFILE MANAGER

A **Snap-on Profile Manager account is required to complete the process.** If you already have a Profile Manager account, log in and go to **Step 3.** (You would have a profile manager account if you have previously accessed SureTrack community or ALTUSDrive.)

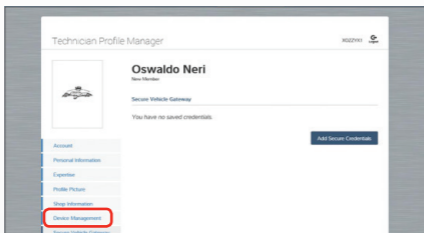

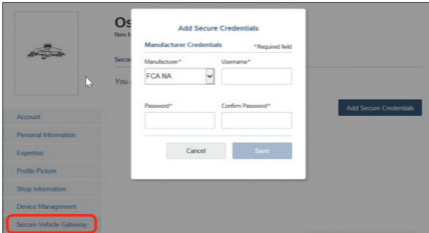
Once your account is created, log back in and go to the **“Device Management”** tab.



Enter your **scan tools pin code, serial number** and **authorization number.**

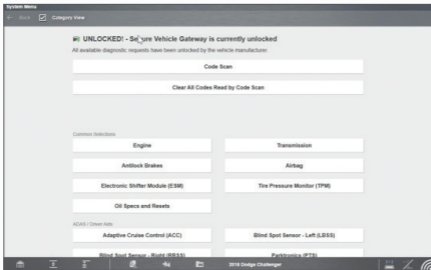
Next, select the **“Secure Vehicle Gateway”** tab and then select **“Add Secure Credentials.”**



Add the credentials you created at AutoAuth or webapp.autoauth.com to access FCA vehicles.

Now you will be able to unlock Secure Vehicle Gateways.
